Glenn has served as a representative in the Washington State Legislature since 2000. He has lived in the Puget Sound region since 1988 and makes his home near Fall City.

He is a business management consultant with more than 20 years experience in corporate finance and marketing. He is the former Director of Business Development for Bellevue Community College.

In his 12 years as state representative, Glenn is a six-time recipient of the "Guardian of Small Business Award" from the National Federation of Independent Business. The award is given every even-numbered year to lawmakers who support policies that bolster small businesses and their ability to create private-sector jobs.

In addition to his committee and interim task force assignments as a member of the Washington State House of Representatives, Glenn has served as president of the Pacific Northwest Economic Region, which is a commonwealth of the five pacific northwestern states and three western Canadian Provinces.
