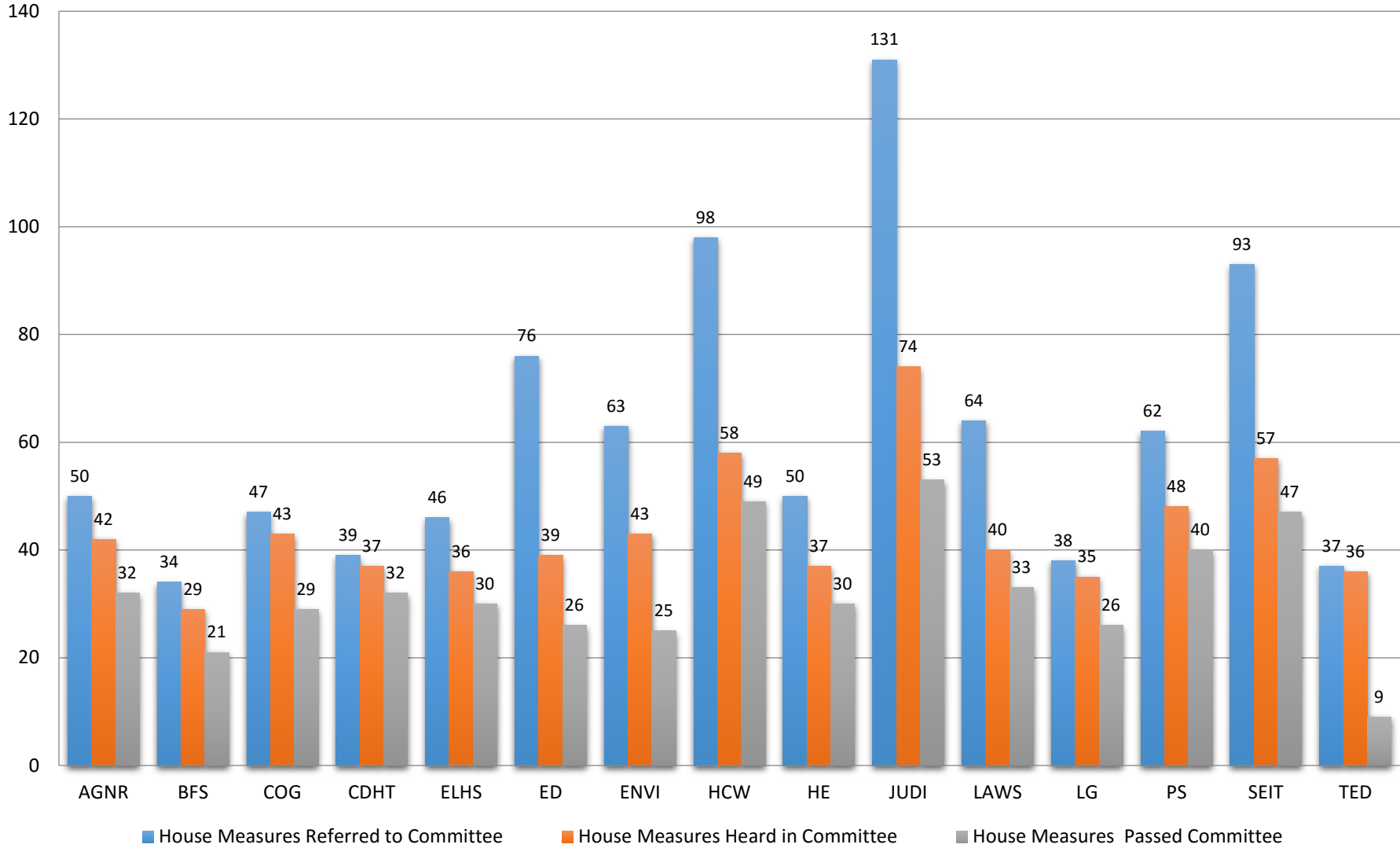
Attached are graphs showing, as of Wednesday's cutoff, the total numbers of House bills: (1) referred to House committees; (2) heard in House committees; (3) reported from House committees; and (4) passed the House. (The number of bills heard is a new data point that I have added to this report.) There are also detailed charts showing bills reported from particular policy and fiscal committees.

As compared to 2015, the numbers of bills referred to and heard by House committees were lower in 2017, but the number of bills reported from House committees was substantially higher in 2017. (That number was 706 in 2017 compared to 535 in 2015.) The number of bills passed the House was comparable in 2017 and 2015.

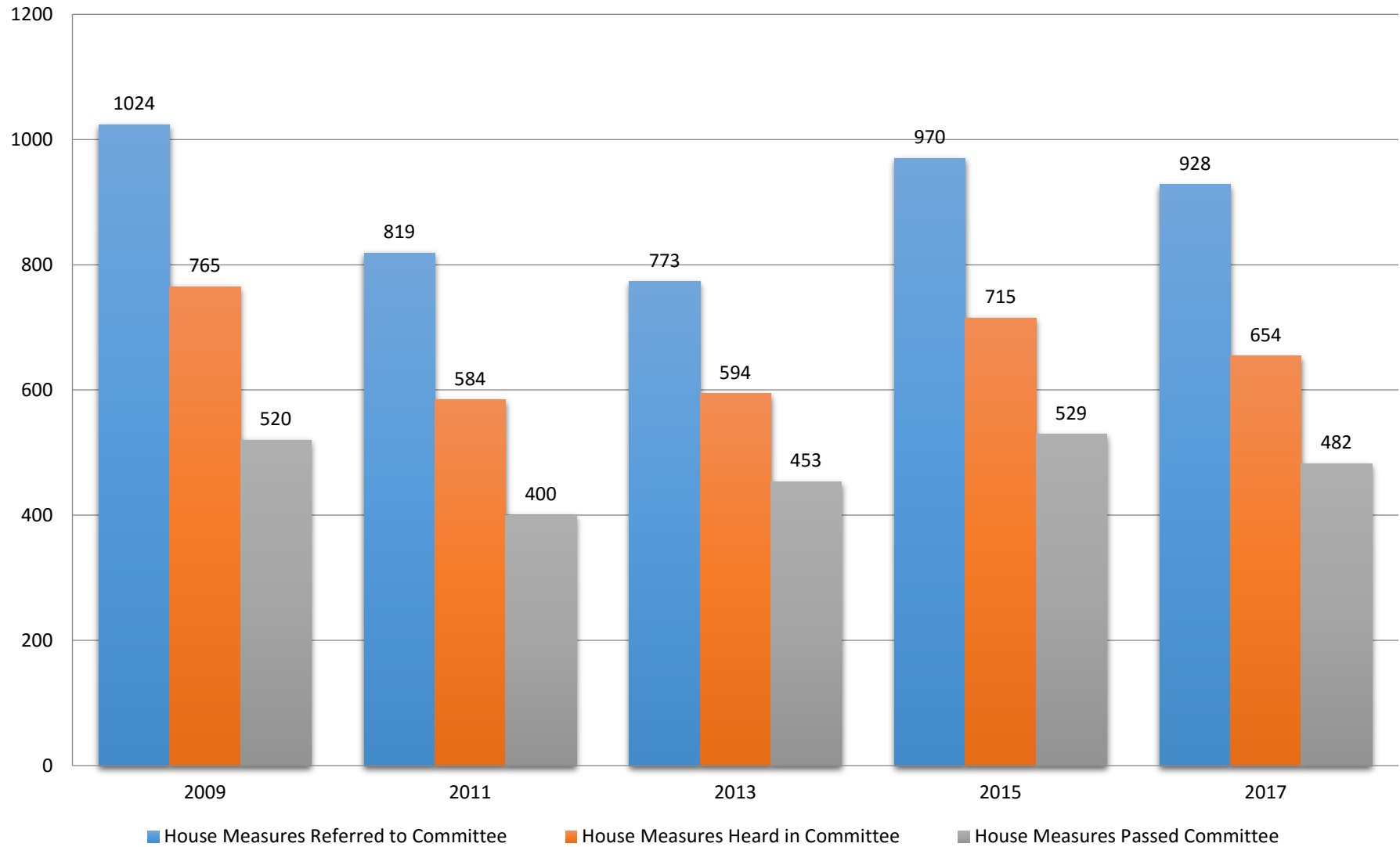

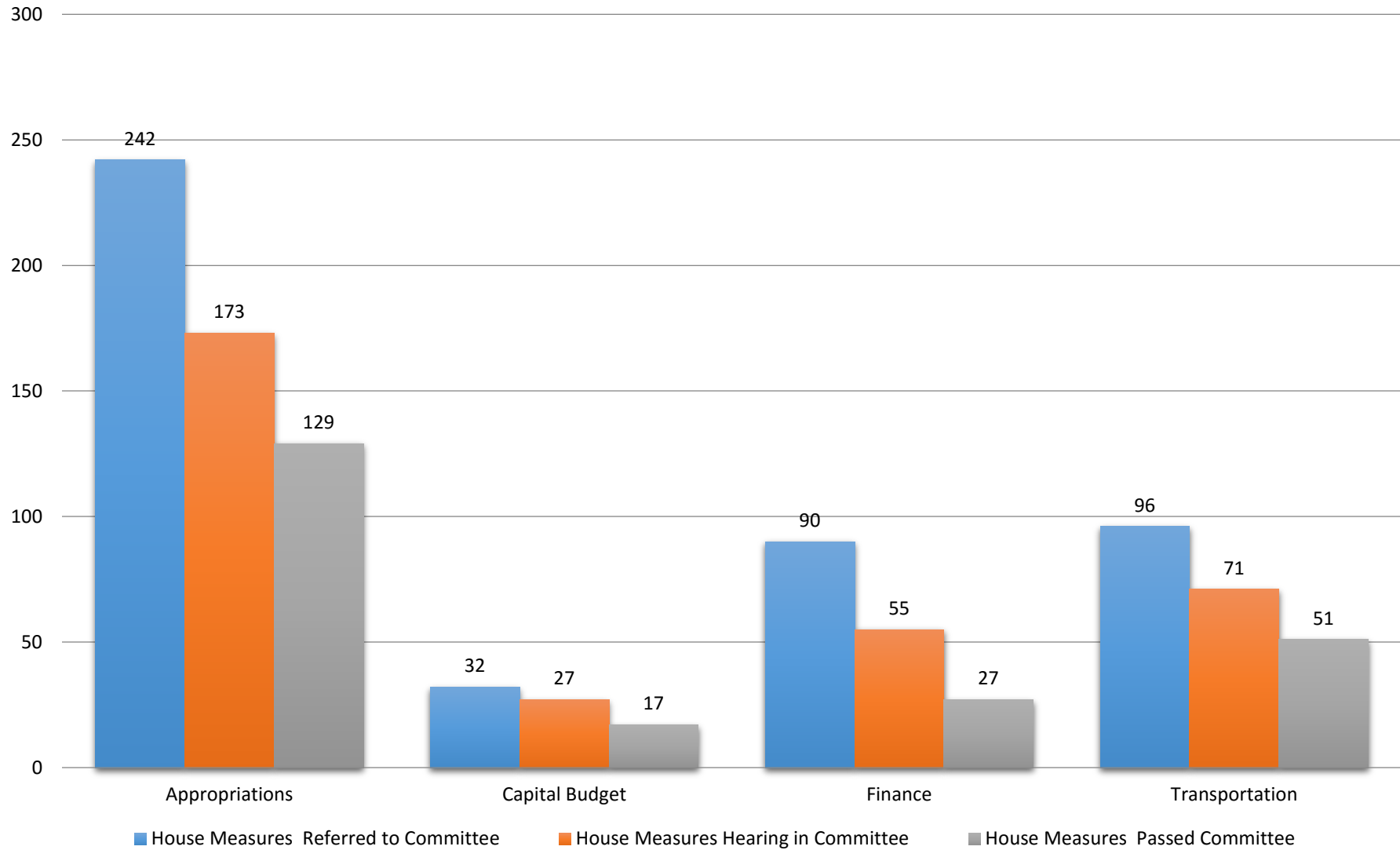
# Policy Committee Activity at Cutoff for House Measures 2017 Legislative Session February 17, 2017



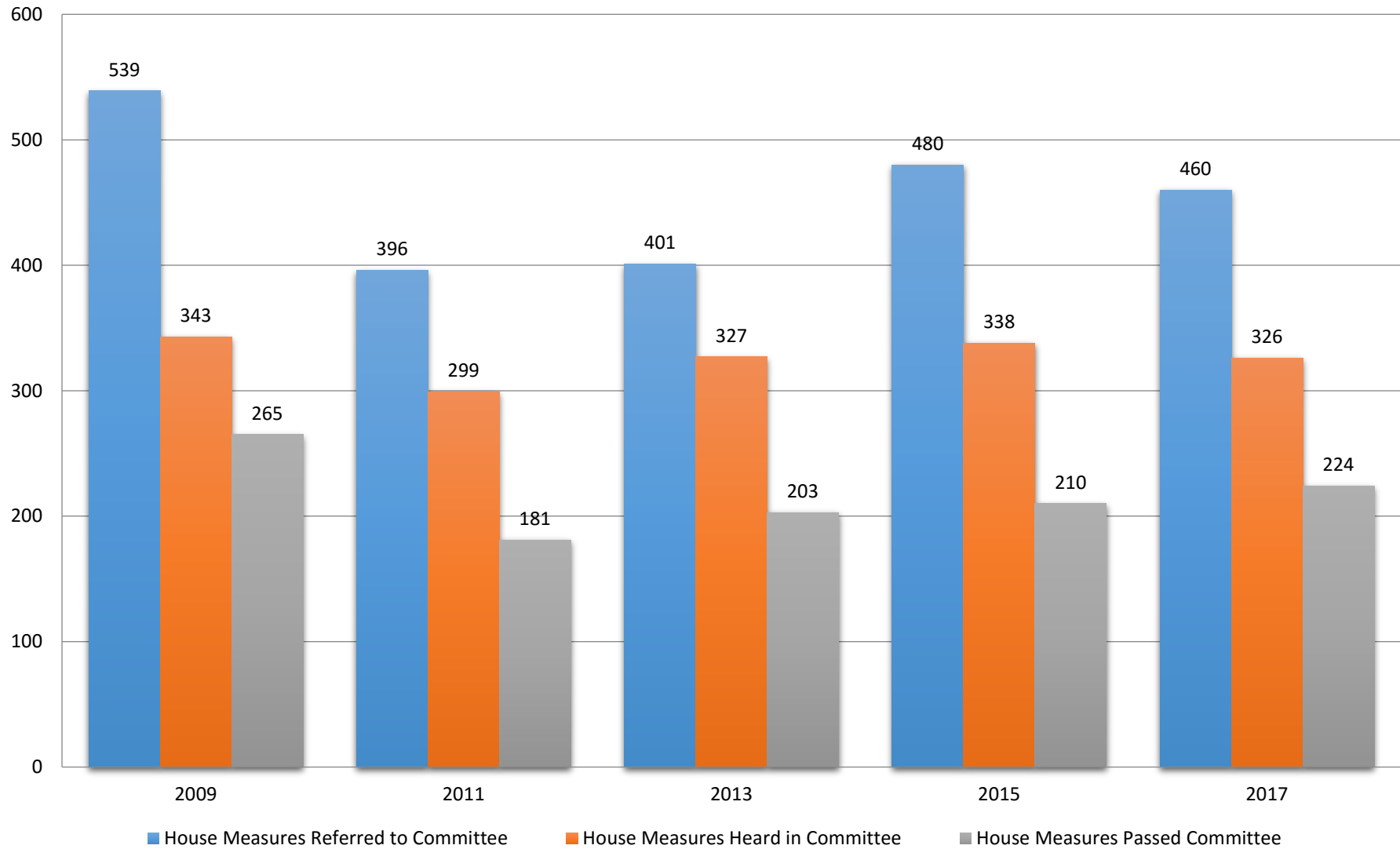

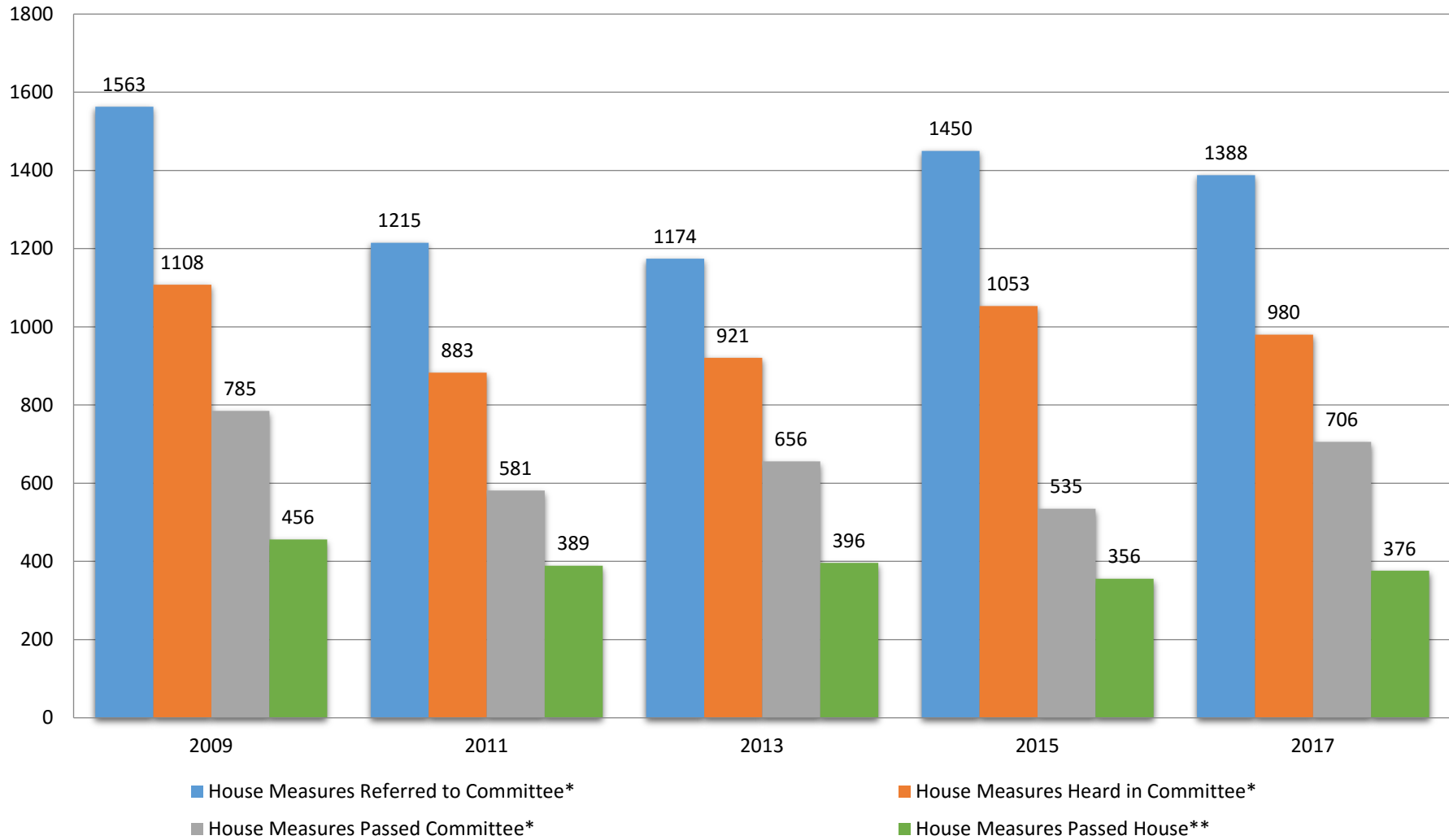
