



House Republican amendments Senate Bill 5096 (transportation budget)

AMENDMENT 484 | Rep. Cary Condotta

- Requires the Department of Agriculture to put stickers/signage on fuel pumps indicating the federal and state tax rates.

AMENDMENT 551 | Rep. Matt Shea

- Removes funding for the Road Usage Charge pilot program, a fuel tax replacement that would require Washington drivers to pay a tax on every mile they drive.

AMENDMENT 528 | Rep. Paul Graves

- Requires Sound Transit to assess vehicles using their Kelley Blue Book value if they want to continue using Department of Licensing (DOL) to collect the motor vehicle excise tax (MVET).

AMENDMENT 512 | Rep. Mark Harmsworth

- Removes operational funding for the I-405 High-Occupancy Toll (HOT) Lanes.

AMENDMENT 496 | Rep. Ed Orcutt

- Removes funding for the Alaskan Way Viaduct unless [House Bill 2193](#) is passed. House Bill 2193 authorizes Seattle to assess a tax in order to pay their agreed-upon share of the cost to build the Alaskan Way Viaduct.

- Allows cities and counties to opt out of all Sound Transit 3 taxes.
