Governor Inslee,

We, legislators representing Southwest Washington, are writing to express our full support for the establishment of new regional law enforcement training centers around the state and urge you to consider building the first one in Southwest Washington.

As you know, Washington has the lowest per capita rate of commissioned law enforcement officers in the country, and the lowest rate in our state's recorded history, since the Washington Association of Sheriffs & Police Chiefs (WASPC) began tracking this data in 1980.

In 2020, Washington had 11,231 full-time commissioned officers. In 2021, that number dwindled to 10,736 – representing a 4.4% decline. Meanwhile, our state's population continues to grow at a brisk pace and the rate of both violent and property crimes remains high.

Tragically, between 2020 and 2021, the rate of violent crime increased by 12.3%, and WASPC reported the highest number of murders on record.

To address this crisis, we agree with your administration that Washington needs more trained law enforcement officers; a sentiment advocated by House and Senate Republicans for many years.

Currently, new recruits are forced to wait months before even beginning their training at the Criminal Justice Training Commission. With only one training center location in Burien, many recruits must relocate far from their communities and families.

We believe Southwest Washington – as one of the fastest growing regions of our state – is an ideal location to train the next generation of law enforcement officers.
