



## Capitol Buzz

Communications staff compiles online articles, columns, opinion pieces and editorials relating to the Legislature, government, public policy, politics and other issues that are part of the legislative discussion. These stories come from a wide range of online sources, including newspapers, TV stations, radio stations and other outlets. We also include links to our caucus social media and legislative communications.

A summary of these stories is emailed out each weekday to Capitol Buzz external subscribers and internal legislative staff and posted to our legislative website at [houserepublicans.wa.gov/capitol-buzz](https://houserepublicans.wa.gov/capitol-buzz). External subscribers can opt out of the email update at any time.

Communications staff may disregard certain stories at its discretion. We do not include stories outside of our designated framework. We do not usually include letters to the editor. Please do not contact us and ask us to include these types of stories in the Capitol Buzz.

While Communications staff may at times link stories that mention a candidate or ballot measure, we make every effort to not include stories in which fundraising, political rallies or other specific campaign-related activities are the central themes. We may link stories that mention candidates or ballot measures if the stories also include other issues related to the legislative discussion. We make every effort to not include columns, opinion pieces and editorials that advocate for or against a candidate or ballot measure. If we inadvertently do so, and it is brought to our attention, we will change the online version of the Capitol Buzz.

**The goal of the Capitol Buzz is to provide a balanced perspective of the issues relating to the legislative discussion. Our intent is to inform – not persuade – readers.** The inclusion of a story should not be construed as support or opposition to a particular issue, viewpoint or person.
